



When developing modules for the DNN CMS platform it is common to use the DNN (core) API to get access to entities like users, roles, settings, files, permissions, etc. Especially for complex modules that contain business logic, it is often desired to write some unit tests to ensure that the code is working as expected. A common problem when writing unit tests for module code using the DNN (core) API is: There is no running "DNN environment" which is required by some DNN core functionality.


