If you are a sports fan in North America, this is an exciting time of year. This is the time when many national sports are just entering the playoff season. NCAA Basketball is about to kickoff March Madness. The NBA is in the last few weeks of the regular season before playoffs begin. NHL Hockey teams are jockeying for a spot in the Stanley Cup playoffs. And golfers on the PGA Tour are getting in their last couple of warmup tournaments before the Masters in Augusta. This is the time when teams make the final push to get into the playoffs for a chance to win the Championship.

Once 7.4.1 is finalized we will quickly shift our focus to the upcoming DNN 7.5. Like the playoffs, DNN 7.5 is a

very big deal. We have some exciting features planned including MVC support, a major refactoring of our Admin modules, a new authentication layer to allow DNN developers to create secure publicly accessible web services and a shiny new skin to show it all off. These are just a few of the high level items being readied for DNN 7.5, which is shaping up to be one of our biggest platform release in the last couple of years.

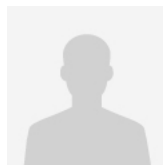
