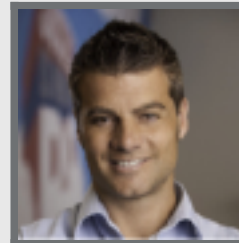




DNN Platform 7.2.2 Coming Soon

The next iteration of the DNN Platform is expected to be released later this month. Over 225 items from our public [Issue Tracker](#) have been resolved over the past 6 weeks, representing a substantial value for our users and customers. This includes the integration of [13 Pull Requests](#) from our open source developer community. Our goal is to optimize and tune every layer of the DNN Platform, ensuring that we focus our attention on real-world scenarios involving large volumes of data, high traffic, and advanced scalability requirements.

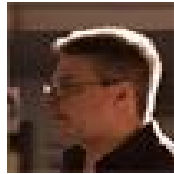
